

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Trustees of the Plano Independent School District will hold a Work Session on Tuesday, October 20, 2020. The meeting will be called to order at 6:00 p.m. The subjects to be discussed are listed on the agenda below. The order in which posted agenda items are taken may be changed by a consensus of the Board Members.

Due to health concerns and in light of the statewide declaration of emergency related to the COVID-19 coronavirus, the Work Session will be held in the Board Room of the Plano Independent School District Administration Center located at 2700 W. 15th Street, Plano, Texas 75075 with limited seating capacity. Early voting is being held in the lobby of the Administration Center; therefore, Work Session attendees will enter from the east side of the building and early voters will enter from the west side of the building. A quorum of the Board will be physically present and the public is welcome to attend, realizing that seating and space is limited based on the Governor's current orders and due to early voting in the lobby. In accordance with the Governor's Executive Order GA-29, and in the absence of any other clear rules and guidelines from the state regarding attendance at in-person governmental meetings during the statewide declaration of emergency, all persons in attendance for the Work Session must wear a face mask and practice six-feet social distancing. Additionally, in accordance with Texas Education Agency guidance for visits by the general public, the District must screen all visitors to determine if the visitors have COVID-19 symptoms or are test-confirmed with COVID-19 and, if so, they must remain off District property. Entry to the Board Room is on a first come, first served basis and individuals will be allowed entry as space is available. Everyone physically present to attend the Work Session must wear a face mask at all times in accordance with the Governor's Executive Order except while the person is giving a speech for a broadcast or to an audience. Any official with authority to enforce the Governor's Executive Order may act to enforce trespassing laws and remove violators.

Recordings shall be made available on the District's website no later than seven days after the date the recording was made and shall be maintained on the website for no less than two years. All video recordings are captioned.

Closed Session will be held for the purposes authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Section 551.001 et seq., including but not limited to the purposes listed on the agenda. If, during the course of the meeting, the Board of Trustees determines that a Closed Session is required for any other purpose, then Closed Session will be held as permitted by the Act as noted below.

For the purpose of a private consultation with the Board's attorney when the Board seeks advice about pending or contemplated litigation or a settlement offer, or when the attorney will have an ethical duty of confidentiality pursuant to **Section 551.071**.

For the purpose of discussing the purchase, exchange, lease or value of real property if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the governmental body in

negotiations with a third person pursuant to **Section.551.072**.

For the purpose of considering a negotiated contract for a prospective gift or donation to the District if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the Board's position in negotiations with a third person pursuant to **Section 551.073**.

For the purpose of considering the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline or dismissal of a public officer or employee or to hear complaints or charges against a public officer or employee pursuant to **Section 551.074**.

To consider the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel or devices or to deliberate a security audit pursuant to **Section 551.076**.

To consider the medical records or psychiatric records of an individual applicant for a benefit from the plan; or a matter that includes a consideration of information in the medical or psychiatric records of an individual applicant for a benefit from the plan pursuant to **Section 551.0785**.

For the purpose of considering discipline of a public school child or children or to hear a complaint by an employee against another employee if the complaint or charge directly results in a need for a hearing pursuant to **Section 551.082**.

For the purpose of deliberating a matter regarding a public school student if personally identifiable information about the student will necessarily be revealed by the deliberation pursuant to **Section 551.0821**.

To discuss or deliberate regarding commercial or financial information received from a business prospect, or to deliberate the offer of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect pursuant to **Section 551.087**.

To discuss or adopt individual assessment instruments or assessment instrument items, or to deliberate a test item pursuant to **Section 551.088**.

To deliberate security assessments or deployments relating to information resources technology; network security information as described by **Section 2059.055(b)**; or the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel, critical infrastructure, or security devices pursuant to **Section 551.089**. Section 2059.055(b) reads as follows:

- (b) Network security information is confidential under this section if the information is:
  - (1) related to passwords, personal identification numbers, access codes, encryption, or other components of the security system of a governmental entity
  - (2) collected, assembled, or maintained by or for a governmental entity to prevent, detect, or investigate criminal activity; or
  - (3) related to an assessment, made by or for a governmental entity or maintained by a governmental entity, of the vulnerability of a network to criminal activity.

For the purpose of a private consultation with the Board's attorney by telephone conference call pursuant to Section **551.129**.

#### 4. PUBLIC COMMENT SESSION

However, in the interest of time and the orderly conduct of business, the Board reserves the right to decrease the perspeaker time limit; take items in a different order than shown on the agenda; recommend that comments involving the performance of District employees be made through the grievance policy; require that comments involving personally identifiable student information be made through the grievance policy; move a meeting or an agenda item to another day in order to allow adequate time for public comment; and make other reasonable adjustments to the timing of public comment in accordance with law. A speaker will be given up to three minutes to address the Board; however, if the total number of speakers exceeds ten, the per-speaker time limit may be reduced. In no event will a speaker be given less than one minute to address the Board. All limitations set forth in Board Policy BED(LOCAL) will apply.
